



## PUBLIC NOTICE: MOVEMENT OF TRANSIT TRUCKS IN LINE WITH THE ONGOING ROADWORKS AT THE MBUDZI ROUNDABOUT ALONG THE **HARARE- MASVINGO ROAD**

The Zimbabwe Revenue Authority (ZIMRA) wishes to inform all its valued stakeholders, in particular, transporters, importers and exporters that in line with General Notice 1173 of 27 May 2022, published in the Government Gazette, Vol. XCX, No. 58 which effected the closure of portions of the Harare- Masvingo Road, Chitungwiza Road and High Glen Road, all feeding into Mbudzi Roundabout, in Harare, all transit traffic shall be expected to follow the alternative and gazetted routes to give way to the ongoing roadworks at the Mbudzi Roundabout.

In conformity with this directive, the Authority has made the necessary administrative arrangements and re-configuration of the Electronic Cargo Tracking System to include the alternative routes specified in the notice, as routes that may be used by transit traffic. Stakeholders are reminded that all other provisions of SI 124 of 2021 [ Customs and Excise (Ports of Entry and Routes) (Amendment) Order, 2021] as amended, remain applicable, including the penal provisions therein.
