

PUBLIC NOTICE: REQUIREMENT FOR TAX CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE FOR PROFESSIONAL REGISTRATION AND LICENSING

In accordance with the recent amendment to Section 80A of the Income Tax Act [Chapter 23:06], ZIMRA wishes to inform all concerned parties of the following important changes regarding the registration and licensing of the following professions:

- Architects (Architects Act [Chapter 27:01])
- Engineers and Technicians (Engineering Council [Chapter 27:22])
- Land Surveyors (Land Surveyors Registration Act [Chapter 27:06])
- Legal Practitioners (Legal Practitioners Act [Chapter 27:07])
- Auditors and Accountants (Public Accountants and Auditors Act [Chapter 27:12] or Chartered Accountants Act)
- Health Practitioners (Health Professions Act [Chapter 27:19])
- Veterinary Surgeons (Veterinary Surgeons Act [Chapter 27:16])
- Real Estate Agents (Estate Agents Act [Chapter 27:17])
- Quantity Surveyors (Quantity Surveyors Act [Chapter 27:13])

All individuals seeking certification, registration, or licensing with their respective professional bodies must present a valid tax clearance certificate at the time of application or renewal. The tax clearance certificate must be valid no earlier than thirty (30) days prior to its submission:

ZIMRA encourages all professionals in these fields to ensure compliance with this new requirement to avoid any disruptions in their practice.

All new registrants have to register through the Self Service Portal (SSP) mytaxselfservice.zimra.co.zw
