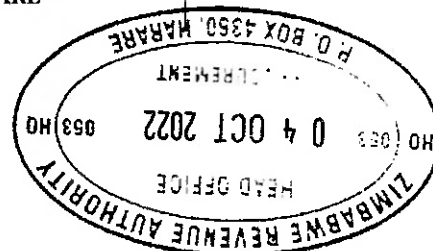

	Maintenance services i.e Brick work, Plumbing, Electrical and Mechanical Works in the past Two (4) Years	i.e Brickwork, Plumbing, Electrical and Mechanical Works in the past Two (2) Years .
5	How are bidders required to state the Proposed Methodology, Work Plan and Schedule as stated on page 17/21?	Bidders are not required to state their Proposed Methodology, work plan and schedule.
